Each student may submit up to five films created since enrolling at the University. Acceptable formats include mini-DV, VHS, DVDs, and iMovie. Digital pieces are accepted on CDs.

R or Macintosh compatible DVDs, excluding DVD-R. Students must make sure their work is compatible with most DVD players. There is no limit on length, but for first viewing, media should be read in the strongest two to three minutes.

Applications are available at the Sage Art Center and the Film and Media Studies office located in Rush River Library, both on the University's River Campus. Applicants are asked to submit applications before submitting their entries. Entries will be collected at the Sage Art Center. All materials must be submitted by Friday, April 20.

Cash prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place winners during a screening of the winning films at the end of the academic year. The Giffin Film Festival, named for Professor Emeritus of English Richard Giffin, is sponsored by the University Film and Media Studies Program. Giffin founded the film studies program at the University in 1976 with the assistance of a grant from the
