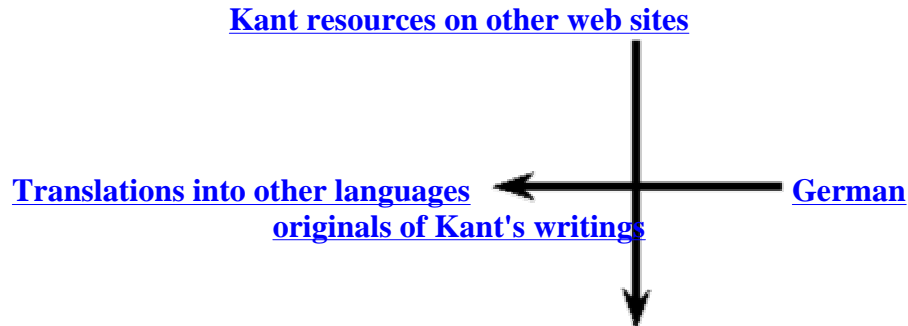


Kant on the Web


