

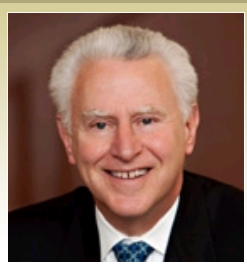

In 2011 he received The Sumantra Ghoshal Award for Rigour & Relevance in the Study of Management from London Business School.

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
