Profile: Wenjie Wu is a professor at Ji Nan University, Guangzhou, China. He has formerly worked in the University of Glasgow (tenured Lecturer/Assistant Professor) and Heriot-Watt University (tenured Associated Professor). He did PhD from the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE). His research interest spans the spatial transformations of urban environment and development, with a focus of using empirical methods to inform public policy. His work has been published in journals such as Journal of Economic Geography, Journal of Comparative Economics, Journal of Regional Science, European Journal of Operational Research, Annals of the Association of American Geographers, and among others. His work has been funded by the Scottish government, ESRC,NSFC and international funding agencies. Apart from his academic works, he has spent time as a consultant expert for the World Bank, China Development Bank and other agencies. He has been awarded as the World Social Science Fellow (Big Data in Urban Contexts) by the International Social Science Council in 2015. From Octbor 2019, Wenjie has been selected as the Global Board of Directors of the International Association for China Planning.
