Cereals have a significant position in land farming in Slovakia. Important commodities are wheat, barley and maize. In the years 1999—2000, a research showed that Slovakia's natural production was lagging behind the developed countries of the EU. Extraordinary low yields were recorded in the economic year 2000/2001 due to drought during the vegetation period. In this paper, there are analyzed the production prices, costs, cereals efficiency and profitability costs.
