## The comparison of natural and value indicators of cereals in the Slovak Republic in accession period to European Union

Cereals have a significant position in land farming in Slovakia. Important commodities are wheat, barley and maize. In the years 1999– 2000, a research showed that Slovakia' s natural production was lagging behind the developed countries of the EU.
