Diagnostics and decision-making of the company management within the period of economic crisis and recession

Enterprises are socio-economic entities with bonds to their environment. Their economic health is evaluated by the means of adequate diagnostic methods. When evaluating a processing business as a living organism, these diagnostic methods enable to determine their health condition. These business entities pass through individual stages of their life cycle and, in real time, their momentary

condition corresponds with the homeostasis existing between the company's system and its environment.
