Title: Age limits of penal liability of the minors

Abstract:

The penal national legislation understood the necessity of raising the age limit when the minor child can answer for the penal nature of the crime he had committed, in order to protect and correct him by social educational means. Only if the court considers that the educative measure is not enough for correcting and reforming the minor, a fine or imprisonment punishment is applied, with the mention that the minimum and maximum limits are reduced to half. In all the cases of penal inquiry or action of minor delinquents, the legislation in the matter provides the obligatory character of social inquiry performed by the Tutorial Authority, which will investigate the circumstances and causes of the crime and will provide the necessary data to the court.
