Sterling Professor of Law and Political Science Bruce Ackerman '67 was honored in the category of "Books" for *The Failure of the Founding Fathers: Jefferson, Marshall, and the Rise of Presidential Democracy* (Belknap 2005), and Yale Law School Dean Harold Hongju Koh was honored in the category of "in-Chief" '81 *Indiana L.J.* 1145 (2006).

Honors also went to Yale Law School graduates Jack Goldsmith '89 for his book (with Tim Wu), *Who Controls the Internet*, to Seth Waxman '77 for his amicus brief in *Smith v. Texas*, and to Adam Liptak '88 and Jeffrey Rosen '91 for their short articles in *The New York Times*.
