At its 317th Session (March 2013), the ILO Governing Body decided that the Technical Meeting will discuss the following agenda items:

1. labour migration in the context of debates on international migration and development of the post-2015 development framework;
2. the effective protection of migrant workers, with reference to the particular vulnerabilities of low-skilled and middle-skilled workers;
3. sound labour market assessment needs, and skills recognition and certification; and
4. international cooperation and social dialogue for well-governed national and international labour migration and regional mobility.

This Technical Meeting will bring together 12 Government representatives nominated after consultation with the Regional Coordinators; 12 participants nominated after consultation with the Employers' group; and 12 participants nominated after consultation with the Workers' group. Other Government, Employers and Workers' delegates would also be invited to attend the meeting as observers.

A background paper for discussion has been prepared for the meeting, available in English, French, and Spanish.
