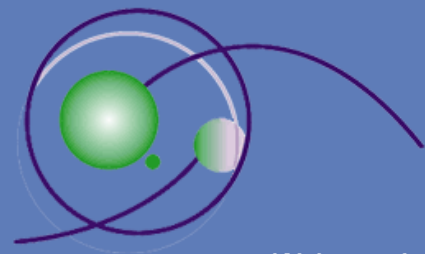

The rates will be approx \$120 at Ibis and \$160 at Novotel for the period 23-26 November. The hotels are part of the same chain, and their reservations team will know that the bookings are linked to the SMAANZ conference Vic Uni and the rates should be easily accessed. The conference venue, Rutherford House, straddles the Railway Station and the Beehive, and The IBIS is 150m away south on Featherston Street, walking south from the Railway Station. The Novotel is about 300m away south on The Terrace.
