CALL FOR PAPERS OF THE 10th CONFERENCE ICLC 2007 IN KRAKOW (CRACOW)

The special theme of the Conference is Cognitive Linguistics in Action: From Theory to Application and Back. Hence specific areas of inquiry involve various empirical validations of Cognitive Linguistics and the feedback for the theoretical assumptions, but the Organising Committee welcomes suggestions for theme sessions and abstracts for papers on all recent developments within the field.

Theme Session conveners are asked to send the proposals of themes to the Organizers by 15th September 2006. Each proposal should include a brief description of the topic of the planned session (max. 500 words). A detailed description of the structure of the session (participants, abstracts of their presentations, names of discussants, breaks), as well as the proposed time allotment should be sent as a single submission, following specifications and submission procedure given for individual papers, by 15th November 2006. Session organisers take responsibility for the quantity and the quality of the contributions to their sessions and make decisions as to which papers are accepted. Participants cannot submit contributions for Theme Sessions without prior consent of session organisers. We ask that neither the presentation nor the discussion by a discussant takes more than 20 minutes.

In case a particular session is not accepted, the Organizing Committee will consider the abstracts for individual presentation

Individual proposals for General and Poster Sessions should take the form of abstracts. An abstract should be maximum 500 words long (i.e. about one page), including examples and references. It should fullfil the following criteria:

- the topic should address the theme of the conference and be of interest for ICLC
- the paper should contribute new knowledge on the topic
- the paper should be well structured and argumented
- data sources should be specified and examples given to illustrate points made
- the author(s) should make clear statement of their results/conclusions

Oral presentation must not exceed 30 minutes, including discussion time.

Posters will be displayed for one whole day, with a time slot left specifically for discussing them. When submitting your abstract, please indicate your preferences and, if your choice is a General Session, please state whether you would be willing to do a poster.

All abstracts must be submitted by 15th November 2006
