biting finish to the day. The crews will compete along the traditional River Irwell course at Salford Quays -

starting at Sam Platts pub and finishing at the Lowry Bridge.

As well as an exciting sporting event, the free Two Cities Boat Race is a social celebration -

with entertainment, food and drink along the quayside. One of the highlights of the day is the dragon boat racing -

a fast and furious race pitting university staff and students, as well as local businesses, against each other.

The University of Salford is preparing for the annual event with a young and strenthened side, extra hours of hard training and a new Registrar, a major fan of rowing who is determined to see his University's club win.
