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

Background

Tom Gold was born in Lockport, Illinois, and began his dance training at age 11 with Larry Long and Warren Conover. He came to the School of American Ballet (SAB), the official school of New York City Ballet, for a summer session in 1986 and was invited to join the New York City Ballet's corps de ballet the following year. In February 1993, Mr. Gold was promoted to the rank of soloist.
