

THOMAS FORSTER



Thomas Forster was born in 1986 in London, England and began his ballet training at the age of 8 with the Royal Ballet School Associate Programme. At age 11 he commenced full-time dance training with Elmhurst School of Dance and then joined the Upper School of the Royal Ballet School in 2002. Forster's performing experience includes principal roles in The Royal Ballet School performances on stage at the Royal Opera House and on The Royal Ballet School's graduation tour to Japan and New York in 2005. He has also performed with the Royal Ballet, Birmingham Royal Ballet and English National Ballet.

He joined the ABT Studio Company in 2005, the main Company, as an apprentice, in January 2007 and the corps de ballet in December 2007. His repertory with the Company includes the Spanish Dance in *Swan Lake* and a leading role in *Baker's Dozen*.

He created a featured role in *From Here On Out*.
