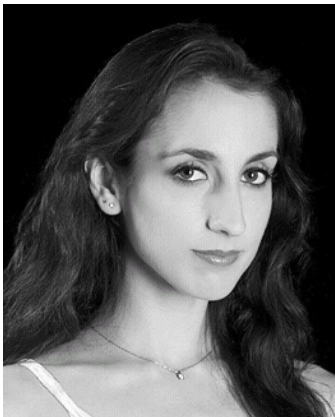


NICOLE GRANIERO

She later trained under Francois Perron, Marina Stavitskaya, and Deborah Wingert at Studio Maestro. In January of 2004, Graniero continued her training under John Meehan at the Studio Company Associate Program, presently known as the Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis School at American Ballet Theatre. She attended summer programs at Ballet Regent, the Chautauqua Festival Dancers, Stiefel and Students, and five years at American Ballet Theatre抐 Summer Intensives. Graniero has performed in *Flames of Paris*, the leading role in *Giselle*, Clara and Dewdrop in *The Nutcracker*, and with American Ballet Theatre抐 production of *Le Corsaire*.

Graniero joined the Studio Company in 2004 and the main company as an apprentice in 2006.
