Renata Pavam, a native of Brazil, began studying ballet at the Centro Mineiro de Dancas Classicas with Ofelia Gonzalez from the Ballet Nacional de Cuba. After the International Competition in Brazil, she received a three-month scholarship to The Washington Ballet in March 1998. From August 1998 to August 2000 she studied with the Jeune Ballet de France in Paris. Pavam has received numerous honors and awards for international dance competitions including the title of 描ost Promising Dancer?at the Nureyev International Ballet Competition in Budapest ?March 2000; the Grand Prize winner of the Concours International de Dance de Luxemburg ? April 1999; the Silver Medal at the USA International Ballet Competition ?1998; and the Silver Medal at the Concours International de Danse de Paris - November 1998.

Pavam joined ABT扭 Studio Company in 2000 and, in 2001, joined American Ballet Theatre as a member of the corps de ballet.
