

Prior to joining American Ballet Theatre, Stappas performed the role of Espada in *Don Quixote*, *Vas Lav3=split* by Mark Dendy and many other classical and contemporary works. He spent two years in ABT担 Studio Company before joining ABT担 main company in 2000.
