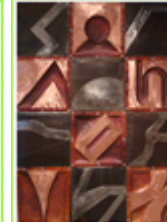
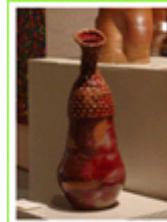

A committee from the Occhiato University Center rewards creative excellence by purchasing award winning student artwork from the Student Art Exhibit each year. A dedicated student exhibition space provides ambitious students the opportunity for one and two-person shows of their work.

The University Fine Art Gallery has been established as a meeting place for the academic community. Professional exhibits, presented bimonthly, along with lectures and university activities provide students the opportunity to experience the best in contemporary and multicultural art.
