Professor Kleiner is the author of more than a hundred articles, reviews, and books, including *The Arch of Nero in Rome* (1985); *A History of Roman Art* (2nd ed. 2017); and the 10th (1995) through the 16th (2019) editions of *Gardner's Art through the Ages*. He was Editor-in-Chief of the *American Journal of Archaeology* from 1985 to 1998 and is a Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries of London. From 2009 to 2012 Professor Kleiner was Secretary of the Text and Academic Authors Association. He has served five terms as Chair of the Department of History of Art & Architecture (1981-1985, 2005-2014) and is one of the three founding members of BU's Department of Archaeology. Professor Kleiner won Boston University's Metcalf Award for Excellence in Teaching in 2002 and has twice received the Distinguished Teaching Prize of the College of Arts & Sciences Honors Program. He has also won the College of Arts & Sciences Prize for Advising in the Humanities.
