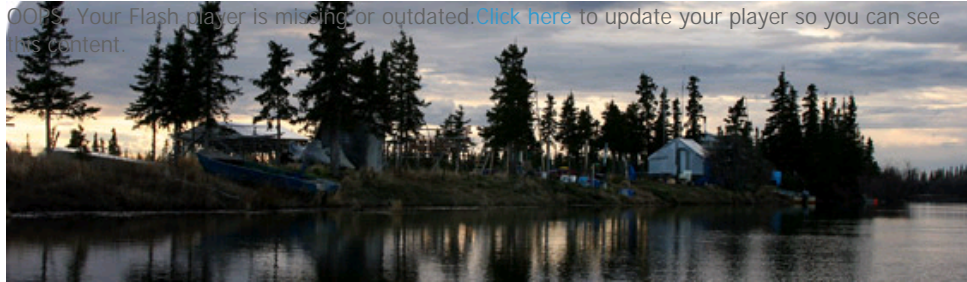

The school hosts an opening reception April 9 for the 37th Frame exhibition of the best work from photojournalism students.

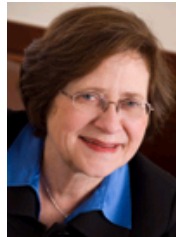
