



Medway is an increasingly popular student destination according to the University of Greenwich & Medway who reported a 20% increase in applications for courses in the region last year. More than 1,000 international applicants study full time or part-time in the future.

The School of Health & Social Care is the Nearer winner, with applications up 30% for courses in Nursing and Speech & Language Therapy, both offered in partnership with Canterbury Christ Church University. The most popular subjects are in the School of Science, which received 1400 applications, and the School of Engineering, which attracted 1270 hopefuls.
