



Bronson Files Lawsuit Against Company For Violating 'Do Not Call' Law

Florida Agriculture and Consumer Services Commissioner Charles H. Bronson announced today that he has taken legal action against a Central Florida roofing company for violating Florida's "Do Not Call" law.

A lawsuit filed in Orange County Circuit Court alleges that First Response Group Inc., an Orlando company that does business as Florida Roofing Contractors, made at least 10 calls to Florida residents on the state's "Do Not Call" list earlier this year. In addition, the lawfully recorded message in some of the calls, which is a separate violation of state law.

"We have little tolerance for companies that ignore the 'Do not Call' law," Bronson said. "When a consumer joins our program, he or she is entitled to be spared from telemarketing calls."

The legal action seeks an injunction prohibiting the company from making any future calls to residents on the list and fines of up to \$10,000 for each of the calls it made to prohibited phone numbers.

Bronson's department has collected or obtained judgements of more than \$1.5 million against companies that have called residents on the list, and several such legal actions are pending in courts throughout the state.
