Dear Reader,

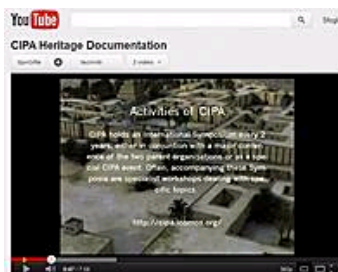

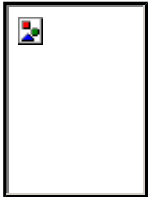
