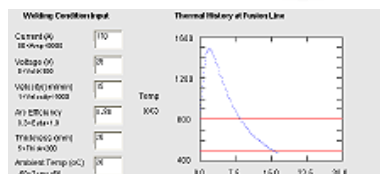
+ WES Standards

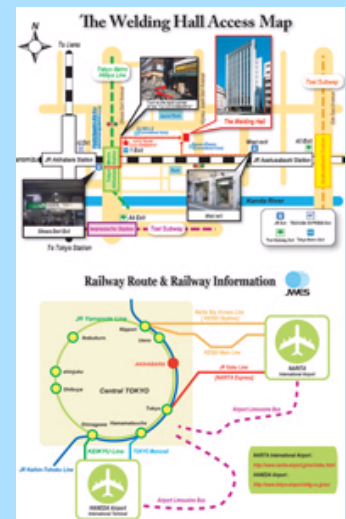
