## What is JOIFF?

JOIFF deals with Fire Hazard Management. While the emphasis in fire hazard management is on prevention, protection and preparation of risk based scenarios, JOIFF members are also the first call officers / incident controllers at emergency incidents. Members, therefore, must be fully versed in all aspects of current fire, security, hazardous material and medical emergency response, and must be able to command operations involving fire and other emergency scenarios of all types varying from very minor incidents through to major catastrophic events.

### Membership

Members of JOIFF are organisations represented by nominated persons who are incorporated in the members' mailing list of JOIFF activities. Full members are organisations with nominated Emergency Responders. Corporate Members are organisations who wish to support JOIFF activities.




### Training

It is both a legal and safety requirement that each member of an organisation's Emergency Response Team receives training that will enable them to perform their duties safely, efficiently and in a competent manner on an on-going basis.



### History of JOIFF

JOIFF was established in 1990 by Industrial Fire Officers in the UK Oil Industry. The value and potential of JOIFF was recognised by Fire Chiefs from Industries outside the Oil Industry and the name of the Organisation was changed to the Joint Oil & Industry Fire Forum.
