hat is JOIFF?

IFF deals with Fire Hazard Management. While the emphasis in fire hazard management is on prevention, stection and preparation of risk based scenarios, JOIFF members are also the first call officers / incident ntrollers at emergency incidents. Members, therefore, must be fully versed in all aspects of current fire, curity, hazardous material and medical emergency response, and must be able to command operations olving fire and other emergency scenarios of all types varying from very minor incidents through to major eastrophic events.
