### Introduction

The 2012 International Symposium on Intelligence Service, Management and Engineering (SIME 2012) will be held in Nanjing, China during November 2-4, 2012. Submission

The papers will be published by IEEE Computer Society Press, available in the conference. All published papers will be included in the IEEE Xplore database and indexed by well-known databases. Prospective authors are encouraged to submit a full paper for review in PDF format. All papers must be written in English. Submit a standard paper should not exceed 4 pages (8.5" x 11", two columns IEEE format), including figures and references with 10-12 point font. The paper should be formatted according to IEEE Author Kit format. And, the PDF paper should be submitted to [MINES 2012's online submission system](#)(SIME2012), or [mines.submission@gmail.com](mailto:mines.submission@gmail.com) with title "SIME 2012".

The accepted papers will be published in the MINES 2012 conference proceedings, which will be published by IEEE Computer Society Press, available in the conference, and indexed by EI Compendex and ISTP. The revised or extended versions of the best papers presented in the symposium will be invited to some refereed international journals.
