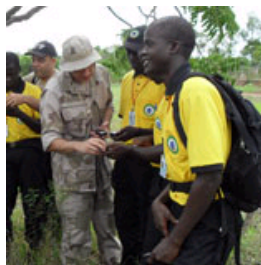
Blue Heart Campaign against human trafficking reaches 10,000 members
