Abstract

Monitoring the demographics of teams increases our understanding of the types of decisions that are made and the processes used to arrive at them. Data from large hotels were collected in both the United States (US) and Singapore. Findings indicate hotel and team characteristics for Northeast US cities are similar to those of hotel managers in Singapore, with the exception of educational level and average salary.
