Program, aimed at individuals ages 18 to 25, has been launched by the National Geographic Society, with support from Lindblad Expeditions.

Twenty-five to 50 grants ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000 will be provided each year to a select number of young adults who apply.

Applications will be reviewed by a subcommittee of National Geographic's existing grant-making bodies. Grants will be made in fields traditionally supported by National Geographic, such as archaeology, wildlife biology, conservation, and adventure.
