Key Accomplishments in 2006


- Served as a partner organization with the American College of Cardiology and the American Heart Association to develop *Guidelines for the Management of Patients with Extracranial Carotid and Vertebral Artery Disease.*
- Forged key strategic alliances with WE MOVE.org and Life in Motion by appointing Susan Heath as the official liaison and with the T.I.G.E.R. Summit by appointing Kathy Baker as official liaison.
- Began producing two new continuing education (CE) workbooks, in partnership with WE MOVE, for neuroscience nurses on Parkinson's disease and dyskinesia, which will be completed in 2007.
- Appointed Hilaire J. Thompson as the editor for the AANN Reference Series for Clinical Practice. Reference Series publications now available online include *Lumbar Spine Surgery: A Guide to Preoperative and Postoperative Patient Care* and *Guide to the Care of the Patient with Craniotomy Post-Brain Tumor Resection.*
- Provided CE opportunities for neuroscience nurses at the first meeting of The World Parkinson's Congress and at the American Association of Neurological Surgeons/Congress of Neurological Surgeons Section on Disorders of the Spine and Peripheral Nerves Annual Meeting.
- Initiated a student membership campaign, offering a complimentary student membership to each chapter to promote neuroscience nursing and support recruitment efforts.
- Made individual Web sites available to each AANN chapter at no expense.
- Restructured the annual meeting so that a number of preconference workshops are hosted by the Special Focus Groups.
- Developed a strategic plan that will guide the implementation of new activities and initiatives of the association from 2007 to 2009.
- Developed the Primary Stroke Center Certification Workshop as a program to be delivered at institutions.
- Developed and released two *CNRN Examination Preparation* products.
- Participated in the Life in Motion Congressional letter-writing campaign to raise awareness of movement disorders.
- Initiated the Best Practices article series in Synapse.
- Experienced a 14% increase in membership and welcomed close to 1,800 new and returning members into the association.

- Experienced a 12% increase in conference attendance, welcoming approximately 1,100 attendees to the 2006 Annual Meeting in San Diego.
- Launched the Online Program Syllabus and CD-ROM, a new format by which the annual meeting program handouts were made available via the AANN Web site and via a complimentary CD-ROM distributed to all meeting attendees.
- Appointed a task force to prepare a draft APN Scope of Practice for Neurosurgery for publication in 2007.
- Selected Las Vegas, NV, as the site of the 2009 Annual Meeting, to be held March 28–31.
- Introduced a redesign of *Synapse*, with the planned redesign of the *Journal of Neuroscience Nursing* and AANN Web site to be unveiled in 2007.
- Published a supplemental issue of the *Journal* of *Neuroscience Nursing* on the topic of stroke in September 2006, including 3 stroke-focused CE opportunities.
- Provided 12,504 online, free CE hours in May.
- Welcomed the Greater Mississippi Chapter, the Oklahoma Chapter, and the Mid-South Chapter.
- Received 2006 Excellence in Association Trends Award, Bronze, Most Improved for *Synapse*, July 2006.


Key Initiatives for 2007

- Submit identified, significant AANN documents to be housed at the University of Virginia historical archives.
- Continue planning the gala celebration for the 40th Annual Educational Meeting by the 40th Anniversary Task Force.



Practice Setting









Years in Neuroscience Nursing










Current Year




Key Accomplishments in 2006

- Recorded the highest total number of certificants, 2,762 as of February 1, 2007.
- Achieved a 69% recertification rate.

- Donated \$5,000 to NNF.
- Implemented the new exam blueprint with the spring 2006 exam, which was a result of the 2005 Role Delineation Study.


Key Accomplishments in 2006

- Funded the sixth annual NNF Special Lecture at the AANN Annual Meeting with Robert F. Spetzler, MD, presenting "Frontiers in Neurosurgery." This lecture was supported by an unrestricted educational grant from UCB Pharma.
- Initiated a research demonstration project to show collaborative research among three leading institutions in the United States. This project is a pilot study exploring the management of patients with secondary head injury using multimodality monitoring and protocols to drive the patient care. The Primary Investigator is Dr. Pamela Mitchell at University of Washington with coinvestigators Dr. Catherine Kirkness and Dr. Hilaire Thompson.
- Finalized strategic business plan document.

- Investigate the feasibility of developing an online database to report and provide access to selected evidence-based guidelines for the care of patients.


