BEST CORPORATE REPORT AWARDS - 2004

The Joint Committee of the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of Pakistan (ICMAP) and the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) announced the final results for Best Corporate Report Awards 2004. Advisor to the Prime Minister, Dr. Salman Shah, who was the Chief Guest on this occasion, awarded the shields to the winners and the runner-ups.

According to Dr. Shah, it was a matter of immense satisfaction that the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of Pakistan (ICMAP) and the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) were contributing significantly to raise the standards of corporate governance in the country by initiating Best Corporate Report Awards in Pakistan.

Dr. Shah hoped that such awards would encourage the organizations, endeavoring to enhance the transparency of their accounts. According to him, SECP is also encouraging the corporate sector to further upgrade the current financial reporting standards in line with the international best practices, which is one of the key factors to enhance the investor's confidence. The need for the development of sound corporate reporting is reflected in the code of Corporate Governance issued by SECP. Based on internationally organized principles, it emphasizes openness and transparency in reporting corporate affairs.

Dr. Salman Shah concluded that the accounting profession would require to keep abreast with the developments in the international standards of accounting and good corporate governance in order to keep pace with the world and upgrade the domestic practices to fill the gaps. Dr. Shah also spoke on Corporate Governance and other related affairs. In the end, he congratulated the winners of the Corporate Reports Awards.

Other speakers who spoke on this occasion included Mr. Muhammad Rafi, President ICMAP, Mr. Zafar Iqbal Sobani, President – ICAP, Mr. Muhammad Ashraf Bawany, Council Member of ICMAP and member of ICAP / ICMAP Joint Evaluation Committee,

Mr. Muhammad Rafi, President, ICMAP said that the aim of introducing the award was to improve the disclosures in the Annual Accounts, to improve the information provided in the Annual Reports and also to improve the Corporate Governance. The awards, Mr. Rafi added, would help in narrowing down the credibility gap, existing between the stakeholders and the corporate management. According to Mr. Rafi, it is a serious problem, which needs to be addressed because of its negative impact on the growth of corporate sector in the country. He hoped that the level of reliance on Annual Reports would greatly improve in the years to come.

Muhammad Ashraf Bawany, Council Member of ICMAP and member of ICAP / ICMAP Joint Evaluation Committee informed the participants that while ranking the nominated companies various criteria were taken into consideration which included vision, mission, report of directors, disclosures, stake holders' information, presentation of the report and timeliness in issuing accounts. Evaluation on Criteria for the next year 2005 is available on the website of both institutes.
