Evolutionary Advantages of Inter-Subjectivity and Self-Consciousness through Improvements of Action Programs



A) Evolutionary advantages of inter-subjectivity and self-consciousness:

- * Anxiety limitation process [1, 2, 3]:
- Inter-subjectivity and identification with suffering/endangered conspecifics => anxiety increase.
- Anxiety limitation by development of Empathy, Imitation, Language, Group life, Inter-subjectivity.
- Positive feedback. Evolutionary advantage.

* Action programs improvements:

- Inter-subjectivity => agent identifies with observed conspecific.
- Agent feels as her own a mistaken action implemented by the conspecific.
- Agent perceives the mistaken action from her position. Different perspective => possibility of new action programs that avoid the mistake.
- Improved action programs are available to the agent. Transfer to conspecifics through imitation processes.
- Evolutionary advantage.



B) Possible link between self-consciousness and phenomenal consciousness:

- * Evolution of the non self-conscious auto-representation towards conscious self-representation:
 - Contains primitive versions of self-consciousness that can introduce pre-reflective self-consciousness [4].

C) Continuation:

- * Describe conscious self-representation and self-consciousness by meaningful representations.
- * Deduce a possible evolutionary nature of pre-reflective self-consciousness.
- * Analyze the evolutionary roots of inter-subjectivity in animals.
- * Analyze possible application to artificial systems and robots.
